If you are able to hold off on writing Daysha's check until Wednesday I can give you what her actual adjusted net will be from the House and the difference from her normal net. The number I had e-mailed previously is just half of her usual net but with the various payroll computations and benefits it's not likely to be exactly half. Half of her net would be \$1867.24. As soon as Payroll sends their data to the Fed Wednesday they tell me they can give me the actual amount she'll be receiving and I will forward that. Sorry I didn't send this late Friday but was hoping I could get confirmation from Payroll this morning.
I'll be in touch Wednesday if you decide to wait for that #. If not the \$1867.24 is half of her previous net.

Hi Congresswoman -

Unfortunately I don't know her net pay - I only have access to the gross charged to the MRA which is \$5088.75. A guesstimate w/ 30% tax and benefit payments would be \$3562. She keeps her benefits but since her gross pay for Oct would be 0 HR would bill her for her normal health insurance premium. If she has life insurance it continues at no charge to her. She still accrues the time towards retirement. If she's contributing to TSP she just wouldn't have a contribution for Oct. Deadline was 15th but Payroll will still process paperwork that causes a reduction in pay. They'll run Payroll next Friday so as long as we submit by then she'll be fine. I also need to know the planned return to work date to list on the form.

Congresswoman -

If we're talking about Daysha, we can't do halftime leave, instead we'd reduce her annual by 1/2 to reflect that she's working halftime. That amount would be \$2544.38 gross. Her health insurance would still be withheld so that would not need to be covered. I can't calculate her actual net difference until after payroll would run but half of her current net would be \$1867.24. Since the Sep. days have passed we could incorporate that in Oct and reflect it in our internal records. A day and a half gross pay is \$254.44 and net, again based on a full month's net, would be \$186.72.

If the intention is 1/2 time for Oct plus off payroll 9/28 and 1/2 day 9/29 I would calculate her annual to reflect the halftime gross of \$2544.38 less \$254.44.

If it's Moises as the halftime scenario I can't give you any net details but can do the same math as above. Halftime would be \$2145.84 plus deducting 1-1/2 days for Sep would be \$208.33. Confusing probably. Once you decide what % of time she/he is working I can calculate and give you actual breakdown.

Thanks for looking into it and just confirm who and what and we'll get it submitted.
