Please amend the response on behalf of Congressman Garrett's to Question 1(a) in our letter to the Committee dated July 6, 2018 to reflect the after discovered information outlined below:

A recent review by Congressman and Mrs. Garrett of their personal records and receipts, discovered the attached receipt for payments on June 19, 2017 from their personal Vendmo Account of \$80.00 to [REDACTED]. [REDACTED], a student at the University of Virginia, had worked as a staffer on the Garrett for Congress campaign, and was an unpaid intern in the Congressional Office in June and July 2017.

While working as a campaign staffer prior to the Congressman's election, [REDACTED] had on occasion driven the Congressman's daughters from campaign events to their home. At the time of the Congressman's response to the Committees questions in his letter of July 6, 2018, it was the Congressman's belief that [REDACTED] had only driven his daughters in his capacity as a campaign staffer, and the Congressman had no specific recollection of any official staff having driven his daughters after he was elected to Congress.

The receipt refreshed the Congressman's present recollection that on a single occasion, on or about the weekend of June 17 18, 2017, [REDACTED] had volunteered to drive the Congressman's daughters from Washington, D.C. where they were visiting Congressman Garrett, to their home in Virginia. Congressman Garrett's recollection is that [REDACTED] offered to drive because he was already planning his own weekend trip, and would be driving in that direction anyway. Congressman Garrett personally reimbursed [REDACTED] for his gas and expenses, incurred (please see attached).







As Congressman Garrett reserved the right to supplement the record with any information that should come to his attention subsequent to his interview, I wanted to pass along some information that Congressman Garrett has subsequently recalled. The first recollection relates to the question of official staff taking his car in for an oil change. Congressman Garrett now recalls that official staff member [REDACTED] told him that there were *two* occasions upon which he had he changed the oil in the congressman's car. Congressman Garrett still only recalls the one occasion that occurred in conjunction with his accompanying foreign ambassadors to Monticello, and while their recollections differ, he holds [REDACTED] in high regard.

The second recollection relates to Committee counsel's questions about a firearm in his office and whether he ever gave staff "specific instructions" regarding it. His answer was something to the effect of "not that I can recall." Congressman Garrett now recalls that he may have spoken with one or two staffers, whom he knew to have been familiar with and competent in the use of firearms, indicating that he kept a firearm in a desk drawer. Further, Congressman Garrett may have instructed those staff members that in the event of an imminent threat to the safety of individuals within the office, there was a firearm in his desk, and that if appropriate under the circumstances, the staff should take actions to defend themselves and others.
