Director of Financial Disclosure (Washington, DC) -- The Committee on Ethics seeks an experienced government ethics attorney to serve as the Director of Financial Disclosure for the Committee. The Director will oversee the Committee's Financial Disclosure Office and will manage a nonpartisan staff of attorneys and other professionals. The Financial Disclosure Office is responsible for reviewing and certifying financial statements; providing legal advice on a high volume of financial disclosure issues; and educating and training Members of Congress and their staff through frequent telephone calls, in-person meetings, and written work product. This is a non-partisan position which requires the ability to serve all Members of Congress equally and refrain from political or partisan activity. Candidates must possess a minimum of 5 years of experience with government ethics, outstanding analytical and written and oral communication skills, the ability to build consensus, and the sound judgment necessary to evaluate the sensitive matters that arise before the Committee. Experience in one or more of the following areas is also desirable: ethics counseling and training, accounting, auditing, investment management, taxation, corporate finance, securities law, and familiarity with Congress and its unique institutional prerogatives. Previous management experience preferred. The salary range for this position is \$161,700 to \$172,500, with the possibility for discretionary bonuses.
